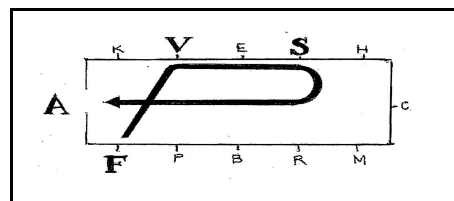

All entries should be submitted online at EqEntries.com (<https://www.eqentries.com/>) with credit card payment. **Before submitting and paying for your entry**, make sure it is complete and that your current negative Coggins (with all information visible) and all releases are uploaded and attached. EqEntries.com charges competitors a 5% fee for processing online credit card entries. If you are unable to enter or pay online, please contact the Show Secretary for assistance. FVSA will assess an \$8 handling fee per entry for any entries not processed and paid through EqEntries.com.

Late Entries: Entries submitted after the Closing Date will be considered late. Late Entries will be accepted only at the Show Secretary's discretion and if space is available. Late Entries will be charged a late fee of **\$10 per class**.

Non-compete Horses: Riders who bring a non-compete horse, *for schooling only*, also must enter online (class 19) and attach Coggins and releases and pay all other fees including office fee and stabling.

Show/Facility Rules

- USEF, USDF, USEA, and IDCTA Schooling Show rules, and current covid guidelines, apply.
- Proper attire required. Show attire optional.
- Ribbons to 6th place. Adult Amateur and Junior/Young Rider Champion and Reserve for GAG/Intro and Training/First.
- Show will take place rain or shine.
- Food concession on grounds.
- No alcoholic beverages allowed.
- Dogs are allowed but must be on a leash at all times and are not allowed in the Club House.
- FVSA is not responsible for any theft, accident, or bodily injury.
- FVSA reserves the right to require stall rental if weather conditions preclude parking on the grass.

Fees (horse stalls include 1 bag of shavings)

- \$20 office fee per horse/rider combination
- \$25 class fee per dressage test
- \$10 late fee per dressage test for Late Entries
- \$45 overnight stall (available 3 p.m. Saturday)
- \$35 day stall (available Sunday)
- \$20 haul-in fee if not renting stall
- \$10 per each additional bag of shavings
- \$15 tack stall (no shavings)
- \$25 camper electric hookup Saturday & Sunday
- \$15 camper electric hookup Sunday only
- \$35 NSF check fee
